

WAYNESFIELD-GOSHEN BOARD OF EDUCATION

Your Board of Education is an arm of the government of the State of Ohio. It is formed and empowered under the State of Ohio. At the same time, it represents the people of our community and is dedicated to protecting and furthering their educational interests.

The Board is non-partism and non-sectarian. The people select candidates and elect Board members to determine the policies under which the schools are to be administered.

The Waynesfield-Goshen Local Board of Education operates as a committee-of-the-whole on all matters of proper concerns. A member of the Board has authority and responsibility only through joint action in official meetings under the Laws of The State of Ohio.

POLICY ON PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS

A place on Board Agenda is set aside for Public Participation. This will take place prior to the business meeting.

The following limitations shall govern Public Participation:

Citizen, in addressing the Board, shall stand and give their names and address.

The public may speak on any items pertaining to Waynesfield-Goshen School.

A speaker may speak on one subject for no longer than five (5) minutes and only one time.

Public Participation should be limited to thirty (30) minutes.

The President of the Board of Education shall conduct the Public Participation part of the Agenda.
